Dear valued stakeholder

In July we contacted you to let you know that the Council had placed the construction of the Gawler Place Upgrade project on hold while alternate design proposals were worked through to ensure that it was more closely aligned to the original \$7.85 million budget and delivers value for money to ratepayers.

At this time, the Lord Mayor Martin Haese also communicated with a number of traders, businesses and building owners in Gawler Place to talk about the project and to listen to their feedback.

This letter is to update you on where the project is up to and what you can expect in the coming months.

Alternate design proposals are being developed for the upgrade of Gawler Place and will be presented to Council for consideration at its meeting on 11 September 2018. Key features of these alternate design proposals, consistent with the original project scope, include street trees, public spaces and areas for outdoor dining, improved lighting and provision for taxis, loading zones and accessible parking.

We will be back in touch with you following this meeting to communicate the outcomes and next steps for the project.

Please note that no matter the outcome of this meeting, no construction works will be occurring over the Christmas and New Year trading period.

Thank you again for your support of the Gawler Place upgrade project and for your patience while these alternate design proposals are being investigated and considered.
